FOREWORD

This document; Guidelines for implementation, **Character repertoires, ordering rules and assignments to the 12-key telephone keypad**, contains national additions to the ETSI standard ES 202 130 specifying the minimum repertoire and assignment of graphic (letter, digit and special) characters to standard 12-key telephone keypads on ICT devices with telephony functionality.

This guideline document has been prepared by the members of the national standardization group for human factors in telecommunications. The Telecommunications Standardisation Advisory Board has discussed this document and recommends it to be followed in Finland.

This GFI document repeals the document GFI 9603 "Guidelines for Implementation; Assignment of alphabetic letters to digits on standard telephone keypad arrays".

NATIONAL AMENDMENTS

The rule in paragraph 6) of clause 5.4 "Keypad assignment for other characters" specifying as follows:

'The full set of special characters must be accessible via one single entry point. It is recommended that this entry point is the "1" key.'

is not a mandatory requirement in Finland.

Note a wrong table number. In clause 5.4 of the standard ES 202 130 (version 1.1.1) the referred table should be 63 instead of 61.
