

1. General

This appendix defines the registration fees and annual fees for ENUM domain names and the invoicing period and invoicing terms used in the agreement.

2. Definitions

"Registration fee"
means a fee collected for each registration of an ENUM domain name in accordance with the service description.

"Annual fee"
means a fee collected for each valid ENUM domain name entered into the ENUM system on the first day of the calendar year.

3. Payer

The registrar is liable to pay the registration and annual fees for the ENUM domain names it has registered in the ENUM system.

4. Fees

The registration fee is 0,5 euros as of 1 January 2008.

The annual fee is 0,5 euros as of 1 January 2008.

Provisions on the fees are laid down in the Decree of the Ministry of Transport and Communications on certain fees of FICORA (1175/2005).

The annual fee is the same regardless of whether the ENUM domain name has been entered into the ENUM system so that it is valid for only a part of the year on which the fee is based.

A registration fee is collected for making changes to a valid ENUM domain name.

The fees shall not be credited or refunded.

5. Criteria for the fees

FICORA collects the fees on the basis of section 6 of the Act on Criteria for Charges Payable to the State (150/1992).

6. Invoicing period

The annual fee is invoiced at the beginning of the year on which the fee is based.

The registration fee is invoiced at the end of the registration year.

7. Invoicing terms

The fee is payable within 14 days of the invoice having been delivered to the subscriber or recipient of the service. An invoice sent by post is considered to have been delivered to the subscriber or recipient on the seventh day after the posting of the invoice.

Complaints about the invoice must be submitted in writing by the due date.

According to section 11 of the Act on Criteria for Charges Payable to the State, the fee may be recovered in the order prescribed in the Act on the Recovery of Taxes and Charges through Execution (367/61).

8. Interest on late payments

Interest on late payments is determined in accordance with the Interest Act.

9. Changes to the price list

If changes concerning the registration fees and annual fees are made to the decree of the Ministry of Transport and Communications on certain fees of FICORA, the annual fees and registration fees collected in accordance with the registrar agreement shall also be changed accordingly. FICORA aims to notify the registrar of the changed prices at as early a stage as possible.

If the fees are changed during the invoicing period, the fees shall be collected in accordance with the decree of the Ministry of Transport and Communications on certain fees of FICORA in force at the time of the invoicing.
